Essential code of conduct for Students' Union Election-2018

Kindly reference to letter no.- BSU-42/2017-87/GS(I), dated- 12.01.2018


Code of Conduct: (Clause 19 of the statute)

- i. No candidate shall indulge in nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
- ii. All candidates shall be prohibited from indulging in or abetting activities which are considered to be 'corrupt practices' and offences, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters; canvassing or the use of propaganda within 100 meters of polling centers, holding public meetings during the period of 24 hours ending with the hour fixed for the close of the poll, and providing transport and conveyance facilities to voters to and from polling centers.
- iii. No canvassing shall be allowed after 10:00 P.M. in the Boys Hostels of the University and Colleges and after 6:00 P.M. in the Girls Hostels on any day.
- iv. No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlets, or any other printed material for the purpose of canvassing. Candidates may only utilize handmade posters and their photocopies for the purpose of canvassing.
- v. No Candidate shall nor shall his/her supporters, deface and write on walls or cause any destruction to any property of the University/College/Institute. All Candidates shall be held jointly and severally liable for any destruction/defacing of any University/College property.
- vi. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes. Places of worship, within or outside the campus, shall not be used for election propaganda.
- vii. Candidates may only utilize hand-made posters at certain places in the campus, which shall be notified in advance by the Chief Election Officer.
- viii. No candidate shall be permitted to carry out processions, or public meetings, or in any way canvass or distribute propaganda outside the University campus.

- ix. During the election period, the candidates holding processions/or public meetings should not, in any manner, disturb the classes and other academic and co-curricular activities of the University. Further, such procession/public meeting may not be held without the prior written permission of the Proctor/Principal.
- x. The use of loud speakers, vehicles and animals for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited.
- xi. On the day of polling, candidates, their agents & supporters shall:
 - (i) Co-operate with the officers on election duty to ensure peaceful and orderly polling and complete freedom to the voters to exercise their franchise without being subjected to any annoyance or obstruction;
 - (ii) Not serve or distribute any eatable, or other solid and liquid consumable, except water on polling day;
 - (iii) Not hand out any propaganda on the polling day.
- xii. Excepting the voters, no one without a valid Identity proof or the current session shall enter the polling booths.
- xiii. The Vice-Chancellor shall appoint observers. If the candidates have any specific complaint or problem regarding the conduct of the election, they may bring the same to the notice of the observer.
- xiv. All candidates shall be jointly responsible for ensuring the cleaning up of the University particularly polling area within 48 hours of the conclusion of polling.
- xv. Any contravention of any of the above rules may make the candidate liable lose his/her candidature, or his elected post, as the case may be. The University may initiate appropriate disciplinary action against such a violator.
- xvi. In addition to the above, the provisions of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (section 153 A and Chapter IXA-“Offences relation to Election) shall also be applicable to the student election.

**Maintaining Law and Order on the Campus during the Election Process:
(Clause 21 of the statute)**

Any instance of acute lawlessness or the commission of a criminal offence shall be reported to the police by the Proctor as soon as possible, but not later than 6 hours after the alleged commission of the offence.
